Suburban Hospital Update

We are pleased that Suburban Hospital is installing cameras at the employee entrance/exit to the Suburban Hospital garage on Southwick, after neighbors reported seeing cars entering the garage from the west end of Southwick and exiting west onto Southwick. Prior to installation of cameras, a parking lot employee is monitoring the employee entrance/exit to prevent illegal turns.

Vehicles not belonging to neighborhood residents are prohibited from turning onto Garfield and Grant Streets from Greentree weekdays between 7:00 and 9:00 am. Please contact an HTCA board member if you are seeing this (school buses excepted), and note license plate number and make and color of car, if possible.

We are very pleased that Suburban Hospital's exterior signage plans were modified, reducing the number, size, and illumination of building signs. This effort required numerous meetings, work sessions, and hearings, including at Suburban Hospital, the Board of Appeals, and with the Sign Review Board.
