RESOLUTION TO RE-OPEN THE RECORD

(Resolution Adopted November 6, 2024) (Effective Date of Resolution: November 15, 2024)

The Board of Appeals has received a letter dated October 29, 2024, from Leslie Ford Weber of Suburban Hospital. Ms. Weber informs the Board that:

In accordance with Condition 20 of the Resolution of the Board dated December 9, 2010, in the above referenced case, this letter is the annual report of the activities of the Suburban Hospital Community Liaison Council in 2024.

The CLC met four times in 2024 on the following dates: January 17, April 24, July 17 and October 16. Copies of the minutes from each of those meetings are enclosed as well as the quarterly noise reports which were presented at each meeting.

Attendance at the meetings ranged from 4-8 community members, in addition to the staff of the hospital. As reflected in the minutes, topics of discussion included: noise testing results, stormwater management, condition of rental properties, snow removal, traffic management, and hospital operations.

CLC meetings for 2025 have been scheduled for January, April, July and October.
